About Tom Aikens

Tom Aikens is one of the UK's most acclaimed and inspirational British chefs. Growing up in Norfolk, with a father working in the wine industry and a childhood spent gardening and cooking with his mother, Tom learnt how to make use of the freshest ingredients, putting food at the centre of his life from a very early age. As a child, Tom and his twin brother Rob would help their mother in the kitchen with the preparation of cakes, biscuits, jams, chutneys and home cooked meals, using fresh vegetables picked from their garden. Tom's mother was passionate about home grown produce, which is where Tom learnt first-hand about the different types of seasonal vegetables that would end up in the home cooked meals they helped to prepare.

Spending most holidays in France, Tom began to develop a real flavour for French food which inspired him to develop his cooking skills further. Tom enrolled at the Norwich City College Hotel School, completing an Advanced Catering Diploma in 1989 and then began his career at Michelin-starred Cavalier's in Battersea, London. He then moved onto The Capital Hotel working under Philip Britten, followed by a chef-de-partie position with Pierre Koffmann at La Tante Claire at a time when the restaurant was awarded with its third Michelin star. Tom later worked for Joel Robuchon in Paris, Gérard Boyer in Reims and Pied-à-Terre to name a few. It was in Pied-à-Terre that Tom became the youngest British chef ever to be awarded two Michelin stars, aged just 26. Tom currently holds a Michelin star at his flagship restaurant, Muse in London.

Tom has been on the London food scene for almost 30 years now, he has amassed a huge amount of experience and knowledge on delivering the very best in his restaurants in the U.K and further afield. Tom has created many different concepts, from the fast & casual to fine dining, delivering all variations of taste and concept needs. He has mastered many cuisines, from British comfort food, health & wellness, to Asian inspired and Mediterranean. Having run restaurants all over the world, from London to the Middle East & Far East, Tom and his team can handle the diversity and complexity of any restaurant opening or high-profile event.

Tom has also written three books: Cooking (2006), Fish (2008), and Easy (2011)

Tom Aikens' views food as the great connector: his understanding and approach to social media sets him apart from the majority the UK's top chefs, sharing a front row seat to his own journey: Tom shares all aspects of his culinary journey and his genuine love of food straight to the user, with no filter. Tom's focus is on using the transformative power of food to create shared experiences and memories. The impetus behind his life's commitment to this industry is a core belief that "great food holds us together and gives us amazing unique experiences at every level."

Principles & Ethics

Sustainability & Ethos

Seasonality and locally sourced produce are incredibly important factors in the preparation of a menu for Tom. He believes in harvesting the freshest ingredients that the changing seasons bring; he is an avid forager and favours using small and local producers whom he knows and trusts that are just as passionate about growing or rearing their wares as Tom is about cooking them.

Tom never uses produce that has been flown into the country from thousands of miles away and is out of season, unless it is tropical fruit. Food that is unsustainable and harvested/caught without respect for nature and the environment is strictly against Tom's beliefs. Supporting locally based suppliers is central to Tom's ethos, this includes using only locally caught fish: he will never serve tuna, Chilian seabass, swordfish or any fish that is not from local fishermen.

Waste Management

This is also a key focus area in Tom's restaurants. For example, Muse, his flagship restaurant in London, takes most food products that might usually be discarded and then uses them in other important components of the menu, such as stocks, sauces, ferments & pickles, flavoured oils & marinades. The left-over sourdough bread is used for poppadom snacks, herb stalks are fermented and used for relish, and vegetables such as leeks are roasted and used in butter.

Respect for Craft

Long before the farm-to-table movement became fashionable, Tom spent time working in the abattoir of Daylesford Farm in order to fully appreciate the traditional trade of butchery. As a master of crafts from butchery to bread making, Tom takes on the traditional with renewed respect and appreciation, elevating it to a new standard.

An ethos of simplicity pervades his restaurants, with the focus on seasonal and home-made ingredients. This stripped-back approach to cooking has nowhere to hide flaws; in his technique and execution of perfect simplicity, Tom Aikens is truly a chef's chef.

Extracts from Fish by Tom Aikens, published in 2008

As highlighted by the below quotes, Tom's stance towards sustainability has been long-standing.

A Snapshot of Fishing Today

"Fishing industry on the verge of ruin' has been a headline we have seen many times and may well continue to be one for years to come. What was once an easy pastime of just placing the net into the sea and hauling in a huge catch has now become an ever-increasing mountain of bureaucracy for fishermen, governments and the EU. The industry has seen dramatic changes and enforced rules, regulations and policies have changed the course of fishing for ever. The words sustainability, provenance, air miles, environmental impact, traceability are becoming the words of today and will hopefully be the future".

A Change in Attitude is Needed

"We need to embrace what we have and start changing the way we think about fish and unless we wholeheartedly support a change in buying practices, the situation of stock demise isn't going to change. Fishermen need to know we are going to support them by buying different varieties of fish. Fish is beautiful, very tasty and exceptionally good for you. It's simple to cook and to prepare, and trying out different species will bring many rewards".

Language of Gratitude and Reciprocity

Tom's guiding philosophy is that great food connects all. Tom is also actively involved in charity work: he has worked closely with various charities including: the Great Ormond Street Hospital Children's Campaign, Royal Marsden Cancer Campaign and School Food Matters. Tom is also the proud ambassador for a homeless charity, Only A Pavement Away that he works closely with on fund raising initiatives.

The concept gives the very best of both British food and cocktail making with a ground floor bar for dining customers and the 1st floor restaurant with an open plan kitchen for guests to dine in.

Designer Rebecca Korner has created the inviting, luxurious interior, combining an eclectic mix of furniture and lighting with exquisite fabrics, decadently rich woods and jewel-toned marbles.

The menus at Muse have been inspired by nostalgia, pivotal moments and key people from Tom's personal life and career. Muse is a person or personified force who is the source of inspiration for a creative artist.

There is a strong focus on the style, charm and sophistication of a great bar combined with a very distinct food experience that will offer a very personal service. 


The style of cuisine at Tom's is of British and French influence, prepared simply, using the best seasonal quality produce from key areas around the globe.

The Marrone open kitchen showcases a lively process. The Himalayan salt-dry meat lockers age the best quality beef; the wood fired grill layers complexity into any simple flavour; the épicerie like shelves offer a wide variety of charcuterie and cheeses along with wide selections of wine.

We are celebrating flavours and harmonising taste and texture, working with the world's best meat, imported or dry aged to perfection in-house, along with poultry and seasonal seafood prepared and cooked "on the bone" which is a superior method of cooking," - Tom Aikens.

Tom has introduced European nostalgia to the Jakarta dining scene with highly styled à la carte Gueridon service of meat carvings, burrata and various desserts. Champagnes and cocktails are also presented and prepared for guests at the table. The burrata trolley is stocked with the finest from Pugliese, complete with fresh garnishes and accompaniments. On weekends, there is roast beef that is carved at the table, thereby ensuring a personalized level of culinary service for the guests. Seasonal seafood towers made up of the freshest seafood sourced from sustainable fisheries are changed daily or weekly dependent on the availability of the freshest produce, which is also a focal dish on the dining table.

Tom's also features a mezzanine lounge that overlooks the restaurant with circular steel stairs connected to the cosy wooden cladded bar which specialises in the largest and most varied whiskey selection in Jakarta.

In collaboration with Executive Chef Jeremy Jouan - a French native with an international culinary background - Chef Tom Aikens has brought to life an authentic yet contemporary take on the bistro experience. Together, they have crafted a menu that embodies the soul of French gastronomy: simple, elegant, and full of character.

The a la carte menu features timeless favourites with a modern twist, executed with remarkable finesse. Highlights include *Escalope de Saumon a l'Oseille* - seared salmon served with a tangy sorrel sauce - and the rustic yet polished *Blanquette de Veau*. Then the Plats du Jour - daily rotating specials inspired by the comforting heart of French home cooking. From *Boeuf Bourguignon* to *Cuisse de Canard Confite*, each dish is a nod to French heritage and seasonality, prepared with warmth and precision. Embracing the needs and desires of a new kind of world-traveller that searches for culinary excellence, The Abu Dhabi EDITION has the **Oak Room**, a traditional English oak panelled steak restaurant, celebrating world-class ingredients with British rock 'n' flair. Offering a wide selection of steaks from all over the world, from Iberico in Northern Spain, John Stone beef from Ireland, Wagyu from Australia, Prime USDA beef from America and Kobe beef from Japan. Expect a classic beef Tartar with watercress pickled shallots carrots and a parsley mayonnaise, seared scallops with piccalilli and curried flavours, pickled beetroot and horseradish in the cured salmon. The menu also indulges in using many British ingredients from treacle and Marmite in the slow cooked short rib of beef.


Market restaurant is inspired by healthy eating, healthy living and wellness, with great fresh produce, different flavours and methods of cooking, from pickling, fermenting, brining and curing, offering unusual tastes and flavours. Market focuses on Asian influences and tastes from Korea and Japan. Delicious salads, raw foods, Poké bowls, broths, vegan, pescatarian and vegetarian burgers, all served in vegetable-based brioche buns, such as spinach kale and spirulina, beetroot and cardamom, and activated charcoal buns. There is even a healthy pizza with a base made from activated chia seeds and grated cauliflower.

Alba Terrace is based on Mediterranean style cooking inspired from the Southern area of France in Provence and the coastal towns of Southern Italy with very light, simple but great tasting food, showcasing quality produce. Expect traditional home-made pasta dishes such as beef ragu with truffle and garlic, prawn and courgette risotto with pistachio, a selection of great pizzas, a fresh Mediterranean salad of raw courgette, fennel, feta and piquillo pepper or black leg chicken, cooked in a salt crust is also a must!

Pots, Pans & Boards, Dubai

Tom opened an eagerly awaited sharing concept serving relaxed meals in a casual friendly environment with small & large family tables as well stools along the kitchen pass.

The menu was a mixture of casual English, Mediterranean and French dishes, with a home-style offering of sharing starters, main courses and desserts. All dishes were cooked and presented in a pot, a pan or a board: with large earthenware dishes, grilled meats and steaks from the pan, along with charcuterie and cured fish served directly on the board – hence the inspiration for the name.

The restaurant interior, designed by Michaelis Boyd Associates, carved inspiration from an old-fashioned rustic home kitchen, with a range of hanging copper pots and pans, old kitchen knives and large heavy cleavers stuck into the walls of antique kitchen tiles. PP&B was a home away from home with a relaxing environment abundant with large communal size sharing tables made from reclaimed wood, suitable for big families and large groups of friends. There were also areas for the individual diners and smaller crowds, with bar stool seats alongside a marble kitchen counter and restaurant area to witness the action from the chefs in the open kitchen plan.

"The concept behind Pots, Pans and Boards stems from my own nostalgia of family and home-cooking in a bustling and comforting environment.
