



About Tom Aikens

Tom Aikens is one of the UK's most acclaimed and inspirational British chefs. Growing up in Norfolk, with a father working in the wine industry and a childhood spent gardening and cooking with his mother, Tom learnt how to make use of the freshest ingredients, putting food at the centre of his life from a very early age. As a child, Tom and his twin brother Rob would help their mother in the kitchen with the preparation of cakes, biscuits, jams, chutneys and home cooked meals, using fresh vegetables picked from their garden. Tom's mother was passionate about home grown produce, which is where Tom learnt first-hand about the different types of seasonal vegetables that would end up in the home cooked meals they helped to prepare.

Spending most holidays in France, Tom began to develop a real flavour for French food which inspired him to develop his cooking skills further. After completing an Advanced Catering Diploma in 1989, Tom began his career at Michelin-starred Cavalier's in Battersea, London. He then moved onto The Capital Hotel working under Philip Britten, followed by a chef-de-partie position with Pierre Koffmann at La Tante Claire at a time when the restaurant was awarded with its third Michelin star. Tom later worked for Joel Robuchon in Paris, Gérard Boyer in Reims and Pied-à-Terre to name a few. It was in Pied-à-Terre that Tom became the youngest British chef ever to be awarded two Michelin stars, aged just 26. Tom currently holds a Michelin star at his flagship restaurant, Muse in London.

Tom has been on the London food scene for almost 30 years now, he has amassed a huge amount of experience and knowledge on delivering the very best in external events and launching <u>restaurants in the U.K and further afield</u>.

Sustainability & Ethos ...

Seasonality and locally sourced produce are incredibly important factors in the preparation of a menu for Tom.

He believes in harvesting the freshest ingredients that the changing seasons bring; he is an avid forager and favours using small and local producers whom he knows and trusts that are just as passionate about growing or rearing their wares as Tom is about cooking them.

Supporting locally based suppliers is central to Tom's ethos, he never uses produce that has been flown into the country from thousands of miles away and is out of season, unless it is tropical fruit. He therefore also only uses locally caught fish: he will never serve tuna, Chilian seabass, swordfish.

Food that is unsustainable and harvested/caught without respect for nature and the environment is strictly against Tom's beliefs.

Long before the farm-to-table movement became fashionable, Tom spent time working in the abattoir of Daylesford Farm to fully appreciate the traditional trade of butchery. As a master of crafts from butchery to bread making, Tom takes on the traditional with renewed respect and appreciation, elevating it to a new standard.

Summary of Deliverables

- Bespoke menu curation
- Ability to collaborate with catering companies, in-house catering teams and/or source event production companies for events that require creative planning and design
- A larger team of chefs and prep kitchen can be used via a third party that Tom works closely with to help execute large scale events
- Preparation of menus are carried out by Tom and his immediate team
- Chef menu training can also be provided for the catering and event companies' team of chefs if required
- Assistance with crockery hire and selection
- Provision of Tom's assistant chef(s) to oversee and cook at the event
- If the client would like Tom to cook at the event, this can be arranged at an additional cost and subject to Tom's availability
- Ingredients ordering can be arranged between Tom and his preferred suppliers, or alternatively an ingredients list can be shared with the event company to order using their suppliers (provided products are in line with Tom's ethos)
- Front of house staff and uniforms are to be provided by the client or catering/event production company
- All production costs in terms of props, equipment, crockery hire, service ware, staffing are managed by the catering/event production company

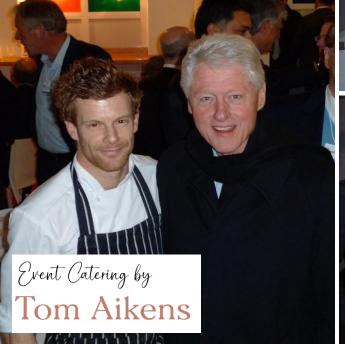

Proposed Fees

Tom and his team can deliver anything from a small private-event to a large-scale one (100+). The fees are determined on a case-by-case basis, and will be tailored to suit the client's needs, but will be based on the following parameters:

Key variables having an impact on fees

- Number of people
- Pre-event preparation time / complexity of menu
- Location of the event
- Ongoing relationship with client or one-off event/relationship

Min fee for a private event (up to 20 pax) with Tom in attendance at the event

Events outside of London/Greater London & Abroad	£20,000
Events in London/Greater London	£17,000

Fee inclusive of:

- Menu curation
- 1 x day of menu tasting & quality control carried out by Tom and his assistant chef
- Tom to attend and cook at the event

Additional guests: up to a maximum of £1k per additional guest, depending on total guest numbers

Min fee for a Large Scale private event (100 pax +) with Tom in attendance at the event

Events outside of London/Greater London & Abroad	£40,000
Events in London/Greater London	£35,000

Proposed Fees (continued)

The following fees would apply in the context of the client only requiring menu curation, without Tom being in attendance:

One off event:

- 1 x seasonal curated menus
- 1 x day of menu tasting/quality control carried out
- Usage limit one day

Fee: £,10,000

Longer term use:

- 1 x spring/summer curated menu
- 1 x autumn/winter curated menu
- 1 x day of menu tasting & quality control carried out by Tom and assistant chef
- Usage limit one year

Fee: £50,000

Expenses

• All food costs + travel expenses + additional members of staff beyond 1 chef assisting Tom is to be charged in addition
